
### RESEARCH PURPOSE

• Goal: Relationships create collaborative expression in which the other changes their social meaning.

## ROLE OF THE ELDERLY WITH DEMENTIA

Had conversations which convey their personal histories

Welcomed the artist without asking where she is from

Enjoyed the artist's dance with crapping and cheers



## ROLE OF THE ELDERLY WITH DEMENTIA

- Had conversations which convey their personal histories
- Welcomed the artist without asking where she is from
- Enjoyed the artist's dance with crapping and cheers

Non-judgmental bodily attitudes change artist behavior and then mind and expression.

"I cannot dance to entertain people"

"I myself am included among them"

### WHAT AUDIENCE SEES ON STAGE

- No ethnic representation of the elderly but their way to live and meet people as usual
- The relationships between the elderly/community members and artists had been constructed through the project.
- The embodied elderly is not a passive object but an unique and influential agent.

## SIGNIFICATION OF EXPRESSION FOR MINORITIES

- Minorities are always represented as fixed image and their body are recognized as object. (hooks.b 2012 Art on my mind: Visual Politics)
- Collaborative expression visualizes active role of the invisible and reflects our perceptual set. (Cf. ランシエール2013 『解放された観客』)
- Attempts for empowerment
